ABOUT THE CHARITY

St John of Jerusalem Eye Hospital Group is a charitable foundation of The Order of St John (like St John Ambulance in the UK) and is the only charitable provider of expert eye care in the West Bank, Gaza and East Jerusalem. In the Occupied Palestinian Territories, the rate of blindness is ten times higher than in the West and over a third of the population lack food security. Without our services, many of these individuals would not be able to seek treatment despite the risk of irreparable damage to their sight. We treat patients regardless of ethnicity, religion or ability to pay.
